- Students must select a challenging program.
- Get as many credits in Level I as possible. If not, you may have to come back for Level IV

# Graduation Requirements

- Possible to graduate from high school and not meet entrance requirements for some post-secondary institutions.
- Note **OTHER** category
- 9 - 3000 level credits to graduate
- But, 10 - 3000 level credits needed for MUN
- Student Planner & Checklist indicate the category that each course satisfies.

## In each of Levels 1-2-3

- Science
- English
- Social Studies (Canada Stds., World Stds.)



# Compulsory Selections

## In Various Levels

- Level I - Healthy Living 1200
- Level II - Career Education 2201 ( in English) or Carrière et vie 2231 (in French) and World Studies for all students
- Any Level - Fine Arts (2 credits: Drama OR Art OR Music OR Clothing/Textiles OR NL Studies

## **CORE English 1201 Academic**

English 2201 + English 3201 [MUN]

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## **CORE English 1202 Basic AND Literacy 1204(Opt. credits)**

Usually Followed by English 2202 + English 3202 (in any order)

Limitations when student finishes school

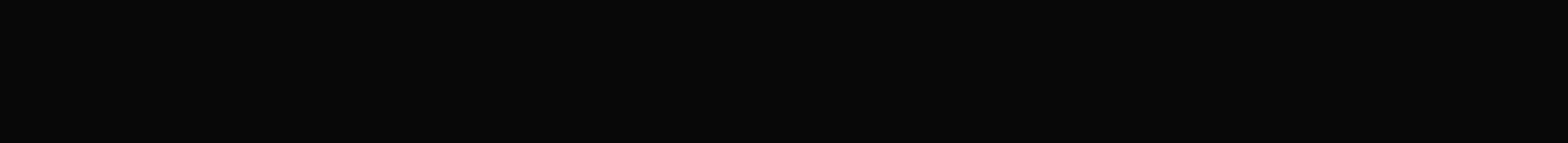

## In Level I:

- **Science 1206**
- **Optional Biology 2201**
- **Semesterized 1206/Physics 2204**
- **Semesterized 1206/Chemistry 2202**
- **Semesterized 1206/Biology 2201**



# Science

## Science 2200 (Level II-III)

### Environmental Science 3205 (Level I-III)

- Having difficulty with science
- Taken by up to 20% of students
- Limitations for post-secondary
- No longer accepted by MUN





# Science

## Earth Systems 3209

- Follows Science 1206
- Can be done in Level II or Level III
- Satisfies MUN entry requirements



# Science

## Biology 2201

- Followed by Biology 3201 in Level III
- Can do Biology 3201 ONLY in Level III without having done Biology 2201



# Science

## Biology 3201

- Can be done in Level II or Level III if you did Biology 2201 in Level I
- Can do Biology 3201 ONLY in Level III without having done Biology 2201



# Science

## Physics 2204

- **Students must have 75% or higher in Science 1206**
- **Followed by Physics 3204 in Level III**



# Science

## Physics 2209 / Physics 3204 Semesterized

- Students must have 85% or higher in Science 1206



# Science

## Physics 3204

- Can be done in Level II or Level III if you did Physics 2204 in Level I



# Science

## Chemistry 2202

- Followed by Chemistry 3202 in Level III



# Science

## Chemistry 2208/Chemistry 3202 Semesterized

- **Students must have 85% or higher in Science 1206**



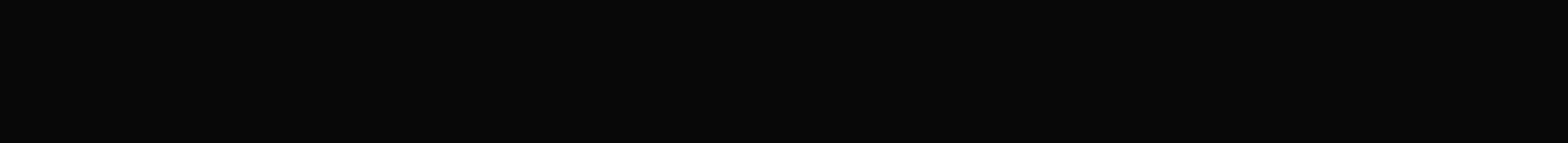

- Can be done in Level II or Level III if you did Chemistry 2202 in Level I

- **Level I: Canadian Studies** [2 credits required]
- **Level II: World Studies** [2 credits required]
